THURSDAY JUNE 28th

1.30pm :

- We will meet together in the lobby of the hotel **Villa Luxembourg, 121 boulevard du Montparnasse, 75006 Paris** (for those who will not stay at this hotel, the place and the hour of the meeting is the same) Then we will walk together to the Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales, **105 boulevard Raspail, 75006 Paris** (10mn walking)

2pm-5pm, Room 8 (Third floor = 2^ostory) :

- Working conference under the title we have proposed :
« **Transference and the symptoms of History** ».
We will explain how we should work together during these 3 hours.
Everybody could think about a brief example of turning points in the therapy, where history was at stake on both sides, the patient's and the analyst's.

last session of the current term :
« **The witty side of madness : Laurence STERNE, The Life and Opinions of Tristram Shandy, Gentleman** ».
During this conclusive session, Ann SILVER and Brian KOEHLER should present briefly the history of ISPS-US to the French audience.
- Then we have only 2 hours to get back walking to the hotel, to pack, eventually to have a little sandwich (there is everything to eat in the TGV train).

We will give you the train tickets offered by Vevey's public psychiatric hospital, for this occasion.

We change the train in Lausanne at 6 37 pm (18h37), for another train to Vevey, 15mn ride along the Lemman Lake.
- At around 7 30 pm, people from the Fondation de Nant (the name of the psychiatric hospital of Vevey) should greet us, walk with us to the Hotel de Famille (1mn walking), for one night also offered by the hospital (please note that the hospital invites us generously, with their own means, not dependent from any pharmaceutical subsidy, in conformity with the ethics of ISPS-US).

Please try to find Vevey in your guides before arriving : you will know about the history of the city, the charming place along the Lemman Lake, the celebrities (Charlie Chaplin had his house at a walking distance from the psychiatric hospital) etc...

Everybody will find easily a nice place to eat in the evening, in the city full of celebrations at the moment of the beginning summer.

You know already that the same Friday June 29th the ISPS Switzerland will be launched, after a Scientific working Day (in French, which is the local language) entitled « Psychosis and Trauma ». You will find the complete program of their presentations when you will arrive at the Fondation de Nant the day after. So we will continue our Parisian beginning with the participants, the hospital offering us the fee of the meeting, the lunch, and the closing Aperitif (which is something in Switzerland).

SATURDAY JUNE 30th

- Breakfast in the **Hotel de Famille**, then a bus will drive us to the **Fondation de Nant** (15mn ride).
After we are joining the program, and the new born **ISPS-CH** will join **ISPS-US**, to continue (in English) on the topic
